

Rules for Staying in Grønttorvsparken

The regulations for staying in Grønttorvsparken have been established by the Grønttorvet Homeowners Association with the objective of ensuring a safe and pleasant environment for all residents and visitors in the park.

All residents and users are encouraged to:

- Preserve the appearance, installations, and trees of Grønttorvsparken.
 - Show consideration towards other residents and visitors.
 - Contribute to making Grønttorvet an appealing destination.
 - Keep dogs on a leash and use dog waste bags.

It is not allowed to:

- Make noise or play music from Sunday to Thursday after 22:00 and on Friday and Saturday after 24:00.
- Bring loose dogs.
- Throw paper and other waste, including cigarette butts, outside of trash cans/ashtrays.
- Hold private parties or larger events.
- Light fires outside of designated fire pits/grills.
- Set up tents, pavilions, umbrellas, play equipment, and similar items.
- Stay overnight in Grønttorvsparken (applies to sheds and hammocks as well).
- Swim or splash in the fountain (including dogs).
- Drink from the fountain (including dogs).
- Damage or remove plants.
- Damage, remove, misuse, or soil the fixtures and furnishings.
- Ride bicycles, scooters, electric scooters, or mopeds.
- Disturb other residents or public order.
- Disturb and annoy others.

Please note that the use of all facilities, including grills, hammocks, and play equipment, is at your own risk.
